

## Student Computer / iPad Contract

Below are policies that will regulate our use of the Internet, computers and iPads. These rules have been designed to keep our technology and classroom functioning at the highest of standards. In order to have access to the Internet, please read the following and sign below.

1. Students are prohibited from bringing any types of food or drinks into any computer lab nor or allowed to have food or drink when using the iPads.
2. Computers and iPads should only be used for educational use and only the programs the teacher allows.
  - a. Social Media, Games, Facebook, Internet Games, YouTube, chat rooms, Instant Messengers, Blog Websites, Fantasy Football/Basketball, etc are **NOT permitted!!!**
3. Bypassing the school's firewall is prohibited.
4. Students may not under any circumstances install software onto the computers or apps on iPads.
5. Students hacking, altering unauthorized files, or using the network in any way other than that intended will lose their computer privileges.
6. Students must not move any equipment or cables. Keyboards, mice and headphones must not be swapped between machines. Headphones are not allowed on iPads.
7. Any behavior which threatens the physical safety of the equipment or other students will lead to the loss of privileges.
8. NEVER give a password to anyone!!!
9. No inappropriate language tolerated.
10. Students are not allowed to change their desktop, screensaver, background etc.
11. Students should save on their P: Drive only when on the computer.
12. Check your workstation/iPad every day when you enter and leave the classroom. Inform your teacher if anything is wrong. The student is responsible for their workstation/iPad.
13. Cyber-bullying is strictly prohibited including, but not limited to the following:
  - a. Send or post cruel messages or images, or sensitive and private information
  - b. Threaten, exclude, harass or intimidate others
  - c. Pretend to be someone else
  - d. Send inappropriate, suggestive or illegal messages or images

These are just to name a few. The students know what is acceptable and what is not.

### Consequences:

- 1<sup>st</sup> offense: Call Home
- 2<sup>nd</sup> offense: Sent to the principal with a referral
- 3<sup>rd</sup> offense: Loss of computer and/or iPad privileges
- 4<sup>th</sup> offense: Removed from class with an F in the class

These policies and procedures must be adhered to, and any violations of them will be met with zero tolerance.

- Students must abide by their signed contracts in addition to the EIS Agreement.
- The use of the computer/iPad is a privilege, not a right.
- If this contract or the EIS is broken, the student's privilege will be revoked.
- I also understand that I may be financially responsible for the repair or replacement of stolen or abused hardware or materials
